

## Rochester Masonic Lodge Scholarship Award





Purpose:

In sponsoring and funding these scholarships, the Masons of Minnesota affirm their faith in education and their devotion to schools teaching all of the children of all of the people. It is their hope that through these grants, outstanding students may be helped to achieve their potential for success in their chosen career through technical education, the liberal arts, or through protracted programs of professional preparation.

## Application and Selection Procedures:

Students in the graduating class of any Rochester high school may apply by submitting an application to the Rochester Masonic Lodge scholarship committee. The deadline for submission of the application to the committee is the second Friday of April. Deadline to submit the application to the high school Guidance office is usually the middle of March sometime and will be noted by that office so they have time to attach the requested records.

Each applicant is required to submit a completed application. All material and information collected for the selection process will be kept private and confidential. The winners will be notified by letter before the school award night. One Graduating Senior from each of 4 major high schools in Rochester will receive \$1000; \$500 from the Rochester Masonic Lodge and \$500 from the Minnesota Masonic Charities. The winners will receive the award checks mid August of this year.
